1. Put the IRC nickname you registered on fuelrats.com here
2. Make sure this box is checked
3. Enter your fuelrats.com password
4. (Optional) Enter any additional channels you wish to enter separated by a comma

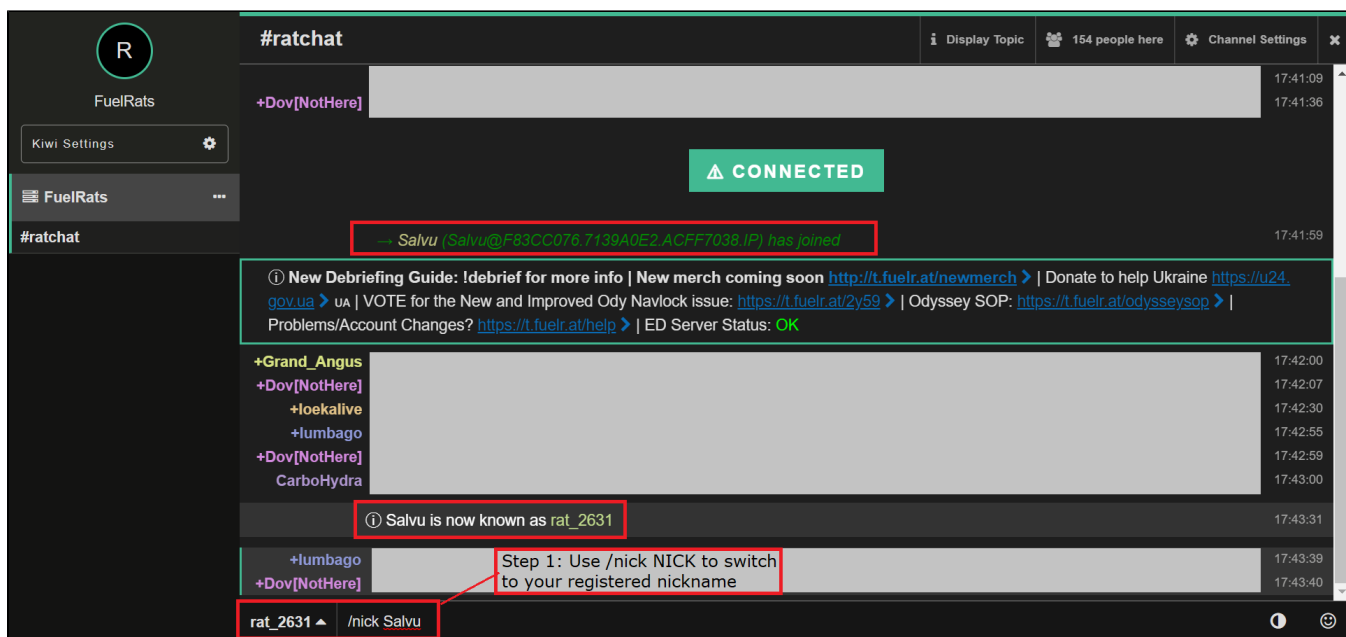

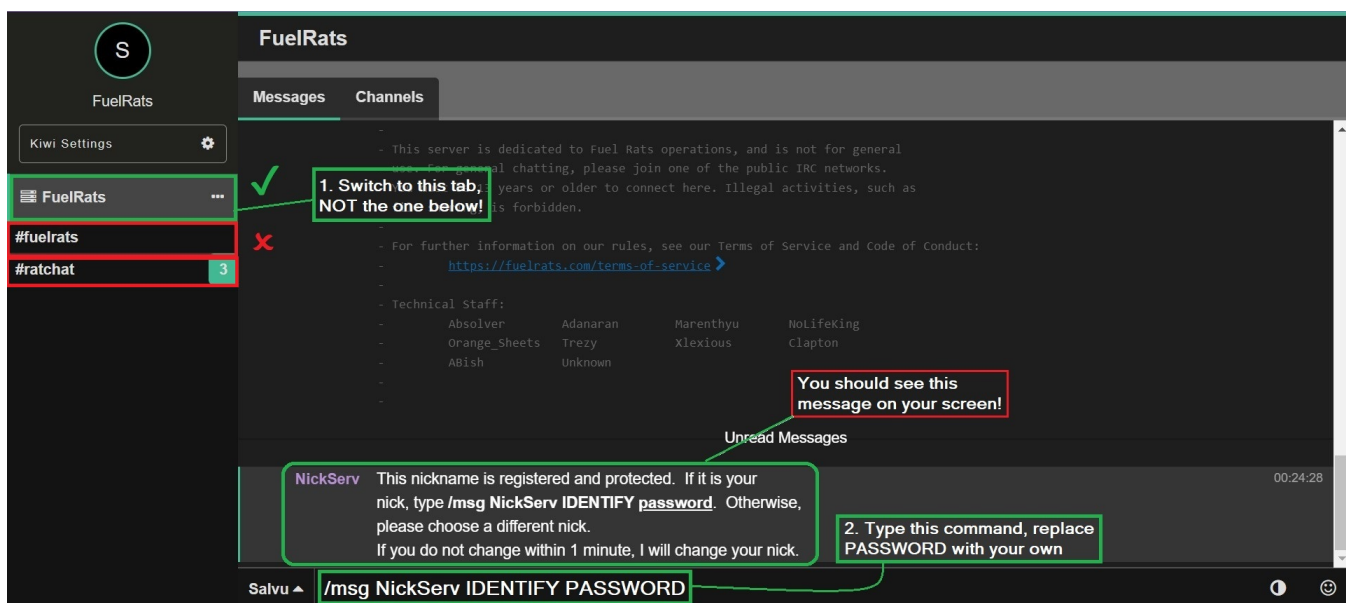
1. If you do not know / remember what your registered IRC nickname is, go to <https://fuelrats.com/profile/overview> and look under *IRC nicknames*
2. Your password should be the same as your [fuelrats.com](#) password.
3. if you are sure you entered your password correctly but cannot identify, check to see if your password contains spaces or special characters. IRC does not allow certain characters in passwords.
4. If you cannot identify, consider resetting your password with the help of [This Link](#) as a last resort.

Option 3: Manually identifying on any IRC client

Step 1: Use /nick NICK to change to a registered nickname



Step 2: Switch to the FuelRats server tab and identify
